When will this be happening?

Monday, June 6 5:00pm-5:30am

Tuesday, June 7 5:00pm-5:30am

Some of the key elements are approximately as follows:

- -11 actors
- -50 background actors "extras"
- -65 crew members
- -15 Wells Fargo clients (and ad agency folks)
- -10 equipment trucks
- -multiple condors w/ high power lights
- -snow machines & art department "dressing"
- -18 horses and 2 Stagecoaches (to be staged at a nearby parking lot near location) *only 6 horses and 1 stagecoach will be called upon at any given time.
- -2 Camera units
- -1 aerial drone (FAA Certified pilot)

Close down Second Street between Durbin and David, including car removal at 5 PM both days. ** Center will remain open between 5-10PM but will be closed late at night for the stage coach scene. Wolcott will remain open between First and Second during 5-10PM but be closed late at night for stage coach (Second to Garage Exit will be closed for "staging area" at 5 PM – you will still be able to exit garage and get to Midwest).

This is how it was explained to us from the production company and many of you have met with them, as well. The DDA did an informal door to door survey yesterday and the feedback was overwhelmingly positive that this was a good thing for our community. Although this is an exciting opportunity, I think it is still important that we have the conversation to thoroughly vet this process and any disruptions to services it may bring so that we all know what we are signing up for. Although short notice, the City of Casper has scheduled an open house at City Hall, in council chambers, to meet with the production company representative and hear more about the plan and get answers to any questions we may have. I also believe it is important that we get those answers and schedules in writing, so we can hold the production company accountable.

If able, please join us at City Hall on Friday, May 27th at 8:30 AM. Your input is critical in the decision making process for city leadership. Again, I understand it is very short notice but please come and participate.
